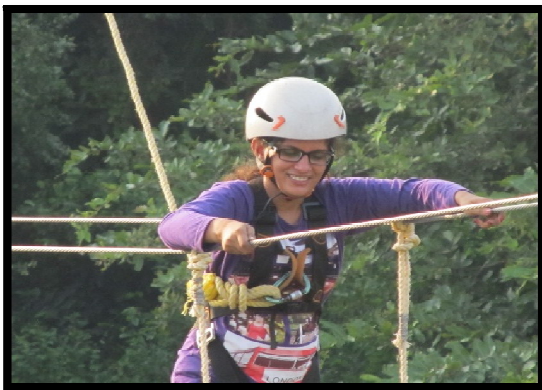

Professors and Researchers from various cities of India were participated in the workshop.



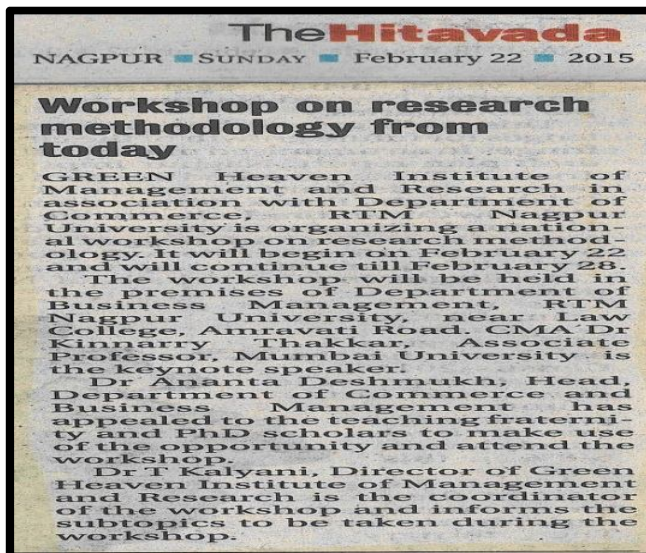

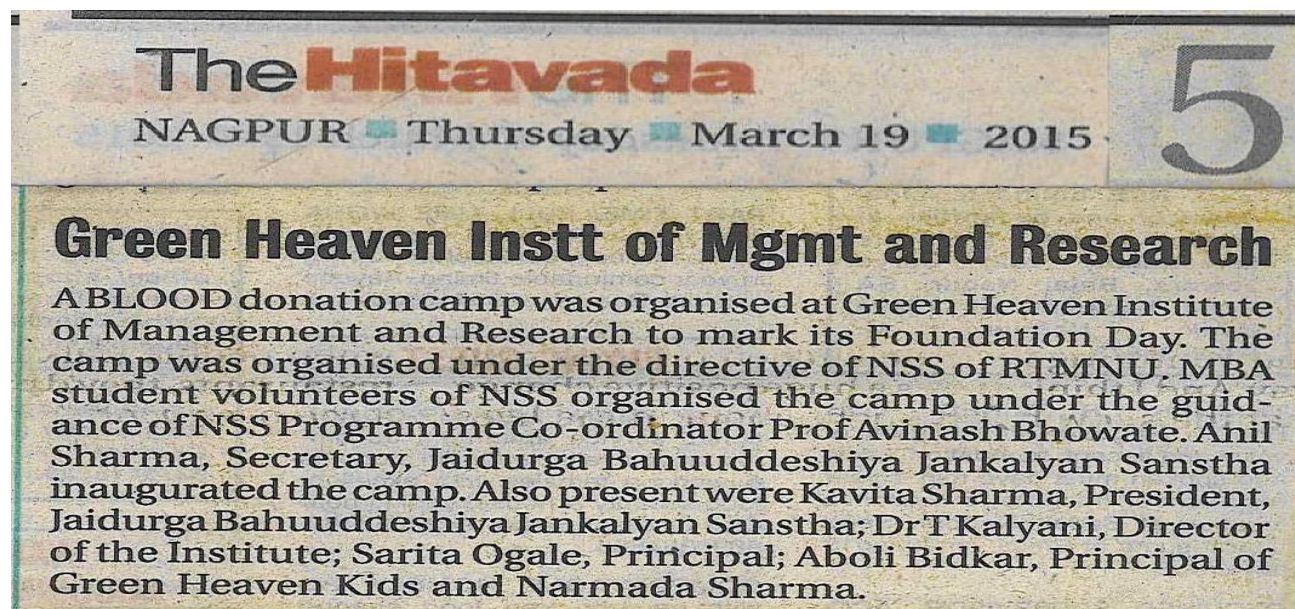
## Foundation Day Celebration –March 8<sup>th</sup> 2015
